Rules & Regulations

1. Al-Noor weekend school is a house of worship and provides Islamic classes as educational opportunities on a non-profit basis.
2. Al-Noor weekend school, its administration or any person associated with it will not be responsible for any injury and / or loss of property at the premises of Raza E Mustafa Islamic Center.
3. It is the duty and obligation of all Muslims to behave and conduct themselves in the best of manners that are exemplary to others. All students are expected to display the Islamic manners. Parents are expected to encourage and monitor their children in this regard.
4. Students need to arrive on time every Sunday. Anybody entering school premises after 12:15 PM is considered late. Upon 3 late attendances, 5 marks will be deducted from their exam marks.
5. While at school students are expected to exhibit good moral characters. Being respectful to all teachers - Being Courteous and helpful, especially towards younger students. Refraining from the use of bad or inappropriate language.
6. No Bullying. Al-Noor school administration will warn the child twice upon the third occurrence; he/she will be expelled.
7. Card Games, Cosmetics, magazines, and all other material that is not associated with Al-Noor school will be confiscated and trashed.
8. Dress Code: Students are expected to dress according to Islamic guidelines of personal modesty. Generally, this means that clothes are loose fitting and not revealing. Also, clothes containing slogans or messages that are obscene or offensive should not be worn.
9. Dress guidelines for Boys - T-Shirts with no human or animal faces or cartoon characters. - Loose fitting pants with waist and belt in appropriate position. No Shorts are allowed.
10. Dress guidelines for Girls: - Full Length dresses, or skirts with full length sleeves. Loose, full length pants - Loose and long sleeve shirts. Hijab to cover hair.
11. Please let us know if your child is allergic to any food
12. Performance Report and Certificate: The school will maintain the performance report based on Attendance, Discipline, and curriculum; a certificate will be issued to successful students.
13. Non-payment of monthly fees can lead to the child being not allowed to attend the school.
14. All concerns should be brought to the School Management notice.
15. School Management has the right to refuse admission.
16. School Management has the right to expel any student based on non-conformity to the school rules.
